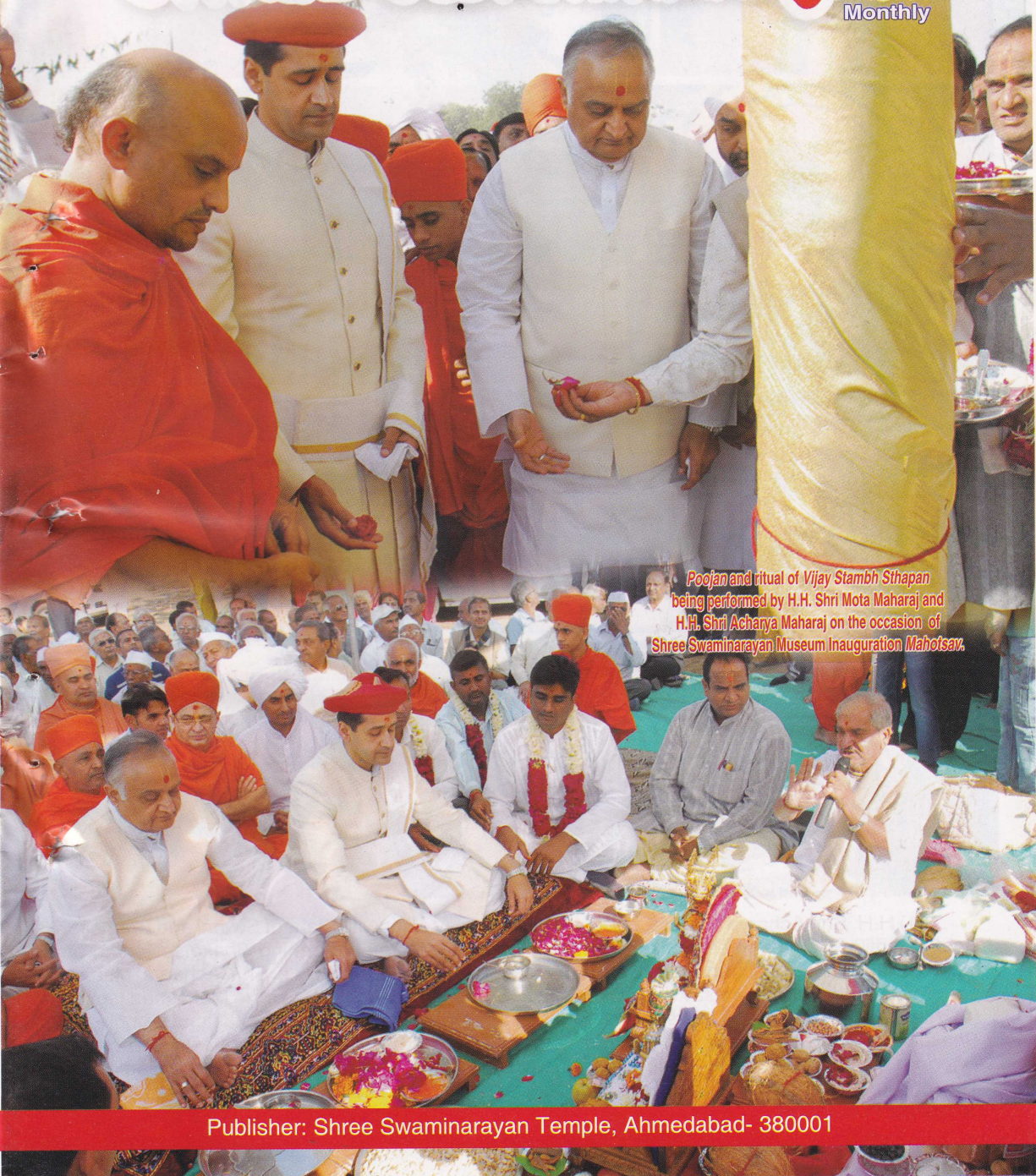

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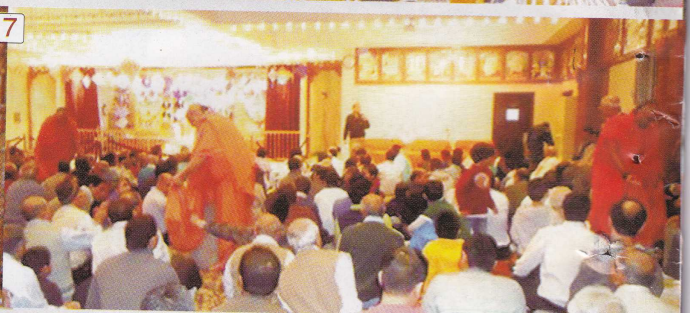

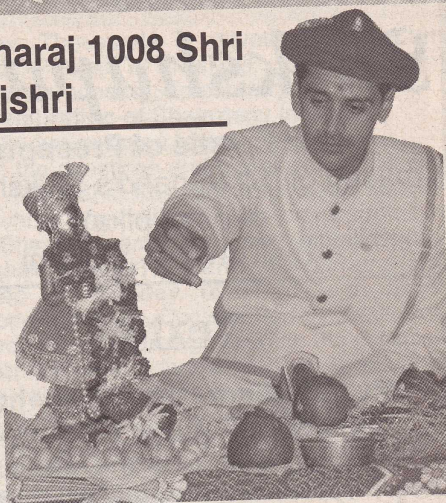

Shikshapatri

The Epistle of Precepts

(based on Shatanand's Shikshapatri
Arthadipika)

Text 44

My Sat-Shudra disciples who are
devotees of Shree Krishna and
Observing their Dharma, shall wear a
Tulsi Kanthi and shall mark
The Tilak similr to those of Brahmins,
Kshatriyas and Vaishyas.

**Sachudraha Krushnabhaktaa Ye Taistu
Malordhvapundrake |
Dwijativadvarye Nijadhsmeshu
Sansthitaiha ||**

Shatanand explains that there are two
types of **Shudras** – *Sachudra* (or *Sat-Shudra*) and *Asachudra*. Shree Hari has
defined a *Sachudra* as a **Krushnabhakta**
and **Nijadhsmeshu Sansthitaiha** – one
who is a faithful Krishna devotee and who is
true to his duty. **Smrutis** further explain :

**Vishudhvanvavasamjato Nivruto
Madhmaisataha |**

**Dwijabhakto Varigvrutiha Sachudraha
Samprakirtitaha ||**

‘Those who are born in a righteous
family, who refrain from meat and alcohol,
who are devoted to Brahmins and who
serve Vaishyas are considered as
Sachudra.’ Those who do not live
according to this code of ethics are
considered as *Aschudra*. A *Shudra* should
be understood as a person of the fourth
caste.

Shatanand explains a *Shudra* as any
‘low born’ and therefore is not exclusively a
member of the fourth caste and as such a

child born out of an affair is considered a
Shudra. However, there are two types of
children born – **Anulomaja** and
Pratilomaja. The following explains the
various *Shudras* or low born. The first are
born out of *Anuloma* or true marriage and
therefore are *Sachudras*.

Murhavshakti – a child from a
Kshatriya mother and a *Brahmin* father.
Ambashta – *Vaishya* mother and
Brahmin father, **Nishad or Parshav** –
Shudra mother and *Brahmin* father,
Mahishya – *Vaishya* mother *Kshatriya*
father, **Ugra** – *Shudra* mother and *Kshatriya*
father. **Karana** – *Shudra* mother and
Vaishya father.

Now are explained those born from a
Pratiloma marriage – *Asachudras* : **Suta** –
Brahmin mother and *Kshatriya* father,
Vaidehic – *Brahmin* mother and *Vaishya*
father, **Chandal** – *Brahmin* mother and
Shudra father (such a *Chandal* as
considered as lowest type), **Magadh** –
Kshatriya mother and *Vaishya* father,
Kshata – *Kshatriya* mother and *Shudra*
father, **Ayogav** – *Vaishya* mother and
Shudra father. Further more, the child of a
mahishyo father and *Karana* mother is a
Rathkar. In this way are defined
Sachudras and *Asachudras*. Those
Sachudras who are *Krishna* devotees, who
wish for salvation, who serve the upper
three castes and who obey their personal
duty have the right to *Diksha*, *Tulsi Mala*
and *Urdvapundra*.

Therefore **Narad Panchratra**
explains, ‘*Brahmins*, *Kshatriyas*, *Vaishyas*
and *Shudras* who desire salvation
(*Mumukshu*) should wear the *Tulsi Mala*,
Urdvapundra *Tilak* and the *Vaishnav*
Mantra (*Diksha Mantra*).’

It was the aim of Lord *Swaminarayan*
to return to the true Vedic teachings and
therefore he taught the true *Dharmas* for
Shudras, giving them back their rightful
place in society.

Jap Mala

- Sadhu Purushottamprakashdas (Jetalpurdham)



In Vedic tradition, *Mala* is considered as symbol of *Siddhi* of *Mantra* and also a symbol of God for *Siddhi* on spiritual path. During the time, when idol images were not easily accessible for a believer, he had to remain satisfied with *Mala*.

There are two types of *Mala* (beads). One which we have to wear; we call it *Kanathi*. The another one is *Jap Mala*. In *Shloka-41* of '*Shiksha Patri*', Shree Hari has stated:

"Those of my Brahmin, Kshatriya and Vaishya disciples who have been initiated into the devotion of Shree Krishna by their Guru shall always wear around their neck a double Kanthi prepared from Tulsi wood and shall mark their forehead, chest and both arms with a Tilak."

In *Vaishnavi Ramanuji* tradition, double *Kanathi* is considered as symbol of soul and supreme Soul and thereby feeling and relation of Master and servant between the Almighty God and devotee is strengthened. Through emancipation of this soul, one should attain Almighty God and for that purpose he should adopt *Kanathi*. In *Adhyay-81* of Chapter-4 of '*Satsangijivan*', Shatanand Swami has stated,

"While Acharya of both Desh asked Shree Maharaj about the ritual of Diksha, Shree Hari replied that, a man intending to obtain Diksha should first take bath and then hold holy fruit in his hands and pray with folded hands to

Almighty Lord seeking His Shelter and should perform Sankalp (take vow) that Almighty Lord Shree Krishna may protect him from Kaal, Maya, Paapkarma (sins) and Yamdut and all types of fear."

काल माया पापकर्म यमदूत भयादहम् ।

श्रीकृष्णादेवं शरणं प्रपन्नोऽस्मि सपातु माम् ॥२७॥

Then Guru should apply *Tilak* with *Prasadi* of *Keshar*, *Kapur* and *Chandan* on his forehead and offer him Double *Mala* (*Kanathi*) of *Tulsi* wood. As a symbol of *Diksha* this *Mantra* and *Mala* are kept by him. After obtaining *Diksha*, this *Kanathi* should always be kept with. If the thread of *Kanathi* is damaged then the thread can be changed but not the beads of *Kanathi*. These beads should never be changed. If *Kanathi* is lost somewhere, then one should go to Guru and obtain a new one, should perform *poojan* with *Tilak*, *Aksha*, *Pushpa* and then it should be worn. Length of *Kanathi* should be upto the heart and not longer one. Through constant touch of each bead of *Kanathi* with the blood veins, it helps smooth blood circulation. Beads of *Tulsi* wood is the symbol of happiness of Almighty Lord.

It is stated in '*Skanda Purana*',

शयने भोजने स्नाने तथा चोत्सर्गकर्मणि । न
त्यजेन्तुलशीमालां त्यजंस्ता दोष भाग भवेत् ॥

One should not be away with *Kanathi* even while performing daily chores. It is also stated in *Skanda Purana* that, Almighty Lord is pleased if one wears *Kanathi*. In *Padma Purana* it is stated that, meals taken by the person without *Kanathi* around his neck are not acceptable. Just

like *Yagno Pavit*, *Kanthi* must always be worn.

It is stated in *Garuda Purana*:

तुलशीकण्ड संलग्नां विसर्गाद्येऽपि न त्येजत् ।

ना शौचं धारणे तस्यो यतः सा ब्रह्मरूपिणी ॥

पूजाकाले तथा ध्याने संध्यादौ नित्य कर्मणि ।

तुलसी दधते कण्ठे ते भक्ताः हरि वल्लभाः ॥

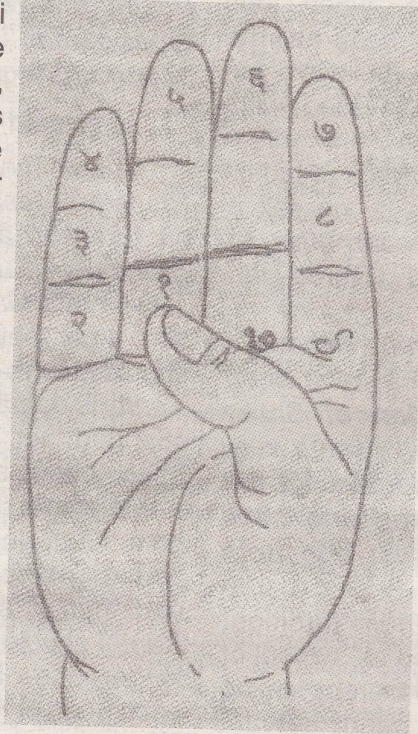
Those who hold *Kanthi* around his neck, while performing *Poojan*, *archan*, Almighty Lord is always pleased with him. One *Mala* is worn and another *Mala* is kept for performing *Mantra Jaap*. *Jap Mala* of 108 beads is considered best, of 57 beads medium and of 27 beads lower one. One can perform *Mala* even in his right palm.

There are various types of *Mala* such as *Tulsi*, *Silver*, *Rudraksh*, *Pearl*, *Darbh* (grass), *Shankh* (conch), *Kamal Kakdi*, *Haladar* (Turmeric), *Baheda*, *Chandan* and *Vaijayanti* etc.

Japa performed through *Mala* should not be counted even with the fruits, flowers, grains etc. it must be remembered that, *Japa* is not for counting.

There are certain rules for performing *Mantra Japa* through *Mala*. It is prohibited to perform *Mala* while walking. However, *Mantra* can be chanted through *Mala* while walking. One should sit at one place and perform *Mala* as without a seat, one does not get any result of such *Mala* or *Japa*. *Mala* should be kept in *Gaumukhi*. *Mantra*

Jaap should always be kept confidential or it should be performed while covering it by cloth. It is stated in the Scriptures that, *Mala* and *Mundra* (money) should be shown to *Guru*. There is peculiar shape of *Gaumukhi* like mouth of a cow. Those who perform *Mala* or *Japa* while keeping *Mala* open, they do not get its result.



While performing *Japa* in the morning, *Mala* should be kept at the height of our navel, in the noon at the height of our chest and in the evening at the height of our nose. *Mala* should not be performed in hurry nor while shaking head. It should begin while performing *Vandan* reverently. One should not speak or talk with anybody while performing *Mala*. There should be complete discipline. *Mala* should not be performed in the bed while sleeping. *Mala* should be performed only after taking bath. On completing *Mala*, we should keep the bead in the temple of our home.

Appropriate fingers of right hand should be used while performing *Mala*. We should not allow the last finger of our right hand to touch the beads as it spoils the whole *Japa*. There is great importance of place where *Mala* should be performed. If *Mala* is performed in *Gaushala* then it gives 100 times more result than one performed in house; still 100 times more if it is performed in forest and still more 100 times if it is performed at the place of pilgrimage,

on the peak of the mountain, on the bank of the river, in Devalaya and in front of the idol image of the God it gives result in an ascending order.

Poojan of Mala should be performed and the following *Mantra* should be chanted:

ॐ अक्षतालधिपतये सु सिद्धिदेही देही सर्व मंत्रार्थ
साधीनी साधय साधय सर्व सिद्धिपरकल्पय
परिकल्पय मे स्वाहा: ।

जपकाले च सिद्ध्यर्थं प्रसीद मम सिद्ध्ये । अविध्नं
कुरु माले: त्वं गृहणामिदक्षिणे करे ॥

There are three types of Japa. In *Nrisinha Purana* it is stated that *Vachik*, *Upashu* and *Mansik*, *Vachik* means to speak very slowly, to speak in such a way that another person does not hears it, to chant *Mantra* in such a way that lips are not moved. One should not allow the Mala to drop from hands and if it drops accidentally

then one should repent it 108 times.

यस्मिन् स्थाने जपंकुर्यान्धतच्छक्रा न नत्फलम् ।

तन्मृदालक्ष्म कुर्वीत ललाटे तिलका कृतिम् ॥

By touching the clay of the place where *japas* are performed, one should speak thrice the words '*Bhu: Bhuva: Swaha:*'. One should not stand up while performing *Japa* and this should be done regularly.

Mala Japa is a king of *Yog Sadhana*. It is not leisure time activity. In the Indian Astrology, with the help of 27 Nakshatra, 12 Rashi and 9 Graha and their place, the past, present and future of a person are foreseen. There are 27 Nakshatra in one direction and thereby total of all four directions (East, West, North and South) comes to 108. and therefore there are 108 beads in one Mala and there cannot be any compromise in this number. A Graph is also given in this article to show how to perform *Japa* with the help of our hands.

Text 45

**My disciples who belong to the
substrata of society shall wear a
Sanctified double rosary of
sandalwood around their neck and
shall**

**Place only a round mark on their
forehead but not a Tilak.**

This *Shloka* is in reference to *Asachudras* and others. They too have the right to serve God but in their case they should not mark the vertical *Tilak*. They should wear only the *Chandlo*. All, regardless of their birth have right to serve and worship the Lord. Even the worst of sinners are cleanses through the worship of God. *Asachudras* do not have the right of *Poojan* or *Murtis*, but do have the right of

Poojan of *Murtis*, but do have the right of *Darshan* and *Naamasankirtan* and therefore need not wear the vertical *Tilak*.

Brahman Purana explains, '*Yagna*, donation, penance, offerings, study and ancestral rites performed without the *Urdvapundra* bear no fruits.' *Shudras* do not have the right to perform any of these acts therefore it is not necessary for them to wear the *Urdvapundra*.

The Lord in this way gives the true Vedic teachings for *Shudras* explaining their rights and duties. A *Shudra* can never be called an '*untouchable*' if he is a faithful devotee of God. Those, regardless of caste who act willfully, breaking the '*Panchvartmans*' are arguably the true untouchables.

Nindat Nahi Koi Devku

Saint Sadguru Premanand Swami of Bhagwan Shree Swaminarayan is now explaining rule nine: '**Nindat Nahi Koi Devku**'. Here Swamiji warns against '**Devninda**' (to speak foul words about the deity). It means that, we speak ill and foul words about those whom we do not like. This is a very bad habit.

There are some people who take pleasure in speaking ill and foul words about others. They worship the gods and goddesses of their like and choice. But they are found abusing deities and gods and goddesses of other religion and of other people. This is not proper. And therefore, Bhagwan Shree Swaminarayan has stated in *Shloka 23* of '*Shiksha Patri*':

"When passing by temples of Lord Shiva and other deities, one shall bow to them and pay due reverence to the deities therein."

Even in *Shloka 84* of '*Shiksha Patri*', it is stated:

"My disciples shall reverently worship the five deities Vishnu, Shiva, Ganapati, Parvati and Surya."

Moreover, Shree Hari established the idol images of the Lord Shree Narnarayandev. But there are some people, who either ignorantly or intentionally abuse the deities established by Shree Hari Himself. But committing such sins, these people will not get anything. They will never be able to please Shree Hari.

Therefore, one should never abuse any deities. Even in *Shloka-21* Shree Hari has stated:

"देवतातीर्थविप्राणां साध्वीनां च सतामपि ।

वेदानां च न कर्तव्या निन्दा श्रव्या न च क्वचित् ॥

"One shall never slander deities, places of pilgrimage, Brahmins, devout wives, priests or the holy scriptures, nor listen to such slander."

Shree Hari has prohibited not only speaking such abuses but also listening to such abuses from others. Because, listening to such foul words or abusing is like committing such sins ourselves.

Like deities, one should not abuse the places of pilgrimage, Brahmins. These Brahmins have been studying the Vedas and thereby they have been helping in preserving Samskaras in our society and therefore they are our pious assets and we should not allow them to be abused by others.

We should also not listen to the abuses about the saints as they are direct messengers of Almighty God and we should not abuse the scriptures as they have science and spirituality very harmoniously blended in them.

It is stated in *Skanda Purana*:

"श्रुति भूदेव देवानां नृप साधु तपस्विनाम् ।

पतिव्रतानां नारीणां निन्दांकुर्यान्न कर्हिचित् ॥

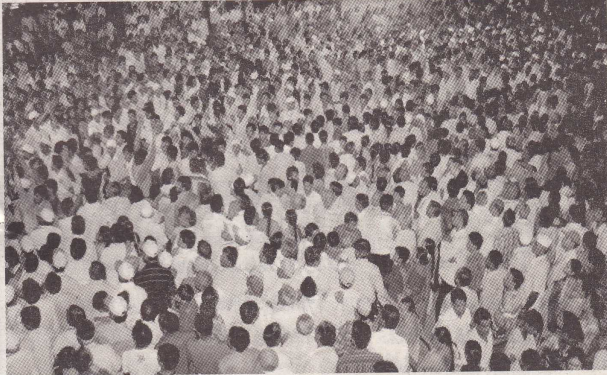
"तीर्थानि देवप्रतिमा निन्देयुर्ये कुबुद्धयः ।

तेषां तु जारजातानां वंशच्छेदो भवेद्ध्रुवम् ॥

Those people who abuse the places of pilgrimage, they get their whole heirs destroyed and therefore even by mistake one should not abuse such places of pilgrimage.

Unique definition of 'Satsang' & its Commentary

- Gordhanbhai V. Sitapara (Hirawadi-Bapunagar)



Almighty Bhagwan Shree Swaminarayan has stated, "It is our wish and desire to spread Satsang in every leaf." Shree Hari has granted so many Utsav in our Sampradaya that we can spread Satsang in every leaf and in every corner of this world through these Utsav and festivals. Lacs of people throng together during such Utsav-Samaiya and everyone will remember and chant the name of Shree Hari. Such a grand Utsav namely Shakotsav was recently celebrated in Sunday 09/01/2011 jointly by all Swaminarayan temples of Bapunagar area.

This Shakotsav reminds us of the famous Shakotsav of village Loya, which was performed by Shree Hari. Along with H.H. Shri Acharya Maharaj- the whole Dharmul graced this occasion of Shakotsav of Bapunagar. All the Three Other Forms of Shree Hari performed Vaghar of Shakotsav; they also blessed the Sabha organized on the occasion. Noteworthy thing about this Shakotsav was that about more than 51,000 (fifty one thousand) Haribhaktas and ladies devotees availed the benefit of Prasad of

Shakotsav.

While addressing the Grand Sabha H.H. Shri Mota Maharaj stated that, "There are so many devotees and people availing the benefit of Prasad of Shakotsav that, it is difficult to say whether this is Utsav or Samaiya of Shakotsav. While defining the term 'Satsang' H.H. Shri Mota Maharaj stated that, "Many learned people define the term 'Satsang' differently but in our view the activities in which we can remember Shree Hari are Satsang and the activities in which we forget Shree Hari are 'Kusan'.

If we think over this, then this one statement tells us so many things in a very simple and lucid way. The very objective of any Utsav or Samaiya is to remember Shree Hari. Otherwise all other festivals are simply the occasion of get together crowding the people at one place. In Utsav or Samaiya of our Sampradaya we organize the programmes such as 'Katha, Parayan, Vishnu Yaag, Dhoon, Kirtan, Sabha, Abhishek, Annakut of Thakorji, Group Mahapooja, Group Mahaprasad. Here Hari is in the centre of all such occasions. If we keep the idol image and name of Shree Hari in our heart and mind then every such occasion would become meaningful.

We should also keep the name and image of Shree Hari before our eyes in all other day-to-day activities of our life. When we get up in the early morning, we should remember the name of Shree Hari, while taking bath we should chant the name of Shree Hari, we should clean the place where we perform puja archan of Shree Hari

and we should also chant Pada of Nitya Naiyam remembering Shree Hari.

When we are preparing the meals in the kitchen, we should remember Shree Hari as if we are preparing and offering Thaal to Shree Hari. We should earn our livelihood and money ethically and we should also offer 1/10th or 1/20th of our earnings in Dharmada. While performing our duties at our work-place we should chant the name of Bhagwan Shree Swaminarayan and we should also observe all the directions given in the pious 'Shiksha Patri' as it is considered as remembering the name of Shree Hari.

We should not talk with others unnecessarily; if we do so or if we get involved in the frivolous activities like abusing others, watching television programmes are reading news-papers or read the books which take us away from Shree Hari in any way then it is a kind of 'Kusang'. Any activity which is devoid of name and directions of Shree Hari is called 'Kusang'. But if we perform *Darshan, pooja, Dhyan, Naam Smaran, Kirtan* of Shree Hari it is called 'Satsang'. Activities of listening or reading Katha-Varta and Charitra of Shree Hari and by following the directions of Shree Hari given in the pious 'Shiksha Patri' are also included in the definition of 'Satsang'.

At last if we remember the worlds of Shree Hari in Vachanamrit of Gadhadra Middle Chapter then Shree Hari says that, "Nothing in this world is more arduous and difficult than concentrating our mind in Shree Hari. And those people who can concentrate their mind in Shree Hari there is nothing greater achievement. Those people who can do this then if they wish to see *Jiv* (soul), *Ishwar* (god) *Maya* and *Brahma*, they can see them easily.

Moreover they can also see *Vaikunth, Golok, Brahm-Mahol* etc. The essence of all this is that, while performing every activity of our life we should remember and chant the name of Bhagwan Shree Swaminarayan. We should not forget Him in happy or unhappy occasion such as birth, death, marriage etc.

Shiksha Patri- Wonderful Boon

- Prof. Suryakant Bhatt (Bhuji- Kachchh)

The main aim of the Lord Shree Sahjanand swami was to uplift the worldly and spiritual life of the people of this world. During His incarnation on this Earth, His aim was to grant emancipation to all the souls of this universe and this is reflected in every word, preaching and sermon of Shree Hari. Social welfare, personal development and emancipation were harmoniously blended together. In all Sampradaya of Hindu Dharma, Moksha (emancipation) is considered to be the ultimate goal of human life. The ways to achieve it are various. The path of Moksha is a spiritual path and the whole life of a person remains fragrant who follows it scrupulously. Simultaneously, people around him also get the spiritual fragrance from him.

During the initial period of the time of Shree Hari, the condition of Dharma (religion) was very dizzy in the society. The ways of worship were not so pure. There was a practice of sacrifice of the animals in Yagnas and there were all social evils prevalent in the society. In the pious company of Shree Sahjanand Swami, thousands of people felt the spiritual height

and upliftment in themselves and thereby they realized that, the Way of Moksha or Mukti is very easy. Sahjanand Swami preached the religion to all the people in their day to day life and make their conduct and routine life very pure, pious and religious. He strengthened the ethics through noble conduct of the people; thus, he not only preached through words but also showed an example through His own conduct as well as the conduct of the saints and the devotees.



In Samvat 1882 (1826 A.D.) Shreeji Maharaj created divine 'Shiksha Patri' on the pious day of Vasant Panchmi Maha Sud-5. Directions contained in this scripture are relevant even today as they are perennial in nature. Many devotees and Haribhaktas perform poojan-archan of the pious 'Shiksha Patri', they chant the Shlokas and every year 'Shiksha Patri Jayanti' is celebrated on the pious day of Vasant Panchmi at various places all over the world. The style of 212 Shlokas of 'Shiksha Patri' is very simple and easy to understand even for the uneducated persons. Noble conduct is at the base of our Sampradaya. While

defining 'Dharma' it is stated:

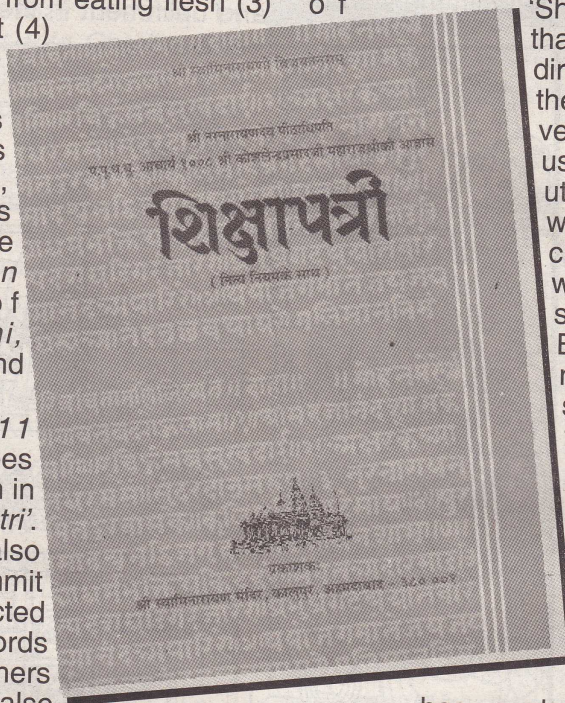
"Conduct endorsed by Shruti and Smruti is real Dharma. This Dharma encourages and strengthens the noble conduct. A follower of Dharma has to take five vows : (1) To abstain from drinking liquor (2) To abstain from eating flesh (3) To abstain from theft (4) To uphold the character (5) To abstain from religious conversion. Besides these five vows, Tyagis or saints should also observe five *Vartman* (principles) of *Nishkam*, *Nisprehi*, *Nirlobh*, *Nihswad* and *Nihseh*.

Sampradaya. Here duties to be performed by Dharmkul as Grihasthi and other special duties are narrated.

From Shloka 175 to 202 of 'Shiksha Patri' duties to be performed by Naishtik Brahmarshis are narrated. A careful study of

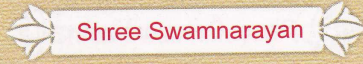
'Shiksha Patri' reveals that Shree Hari has directed to perform all the duties of daily life very diligently such as using clean clothes and utensils, to sieve the water with a piece of cloth & it is also stated what is an ideal schedule of the day. Besides this, it is also narrated about the special care to be taken during the times of Solar and Lunar eclipse. Chatur Maas etc. Duties of Brahmarshis are also narrated in detail. Shree Sahjanand Swami

has explained the forms of 'Ishwar' (god), Maya, Jiv (soul) Gyan (knowledge) Dharma (Religion) and Vairagya (Renunciation). Thus, this pious 'Shiksha Patri' is a wonderful boon in human life for the welfare and emancipation of all the souls of this world. Shree Sahjanand Swami has stated that, "our words themselves are our own Form." and has directed all the devotees and Haribhaktas to follow it scrupulously.

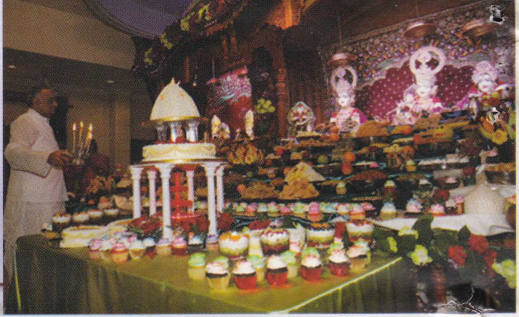

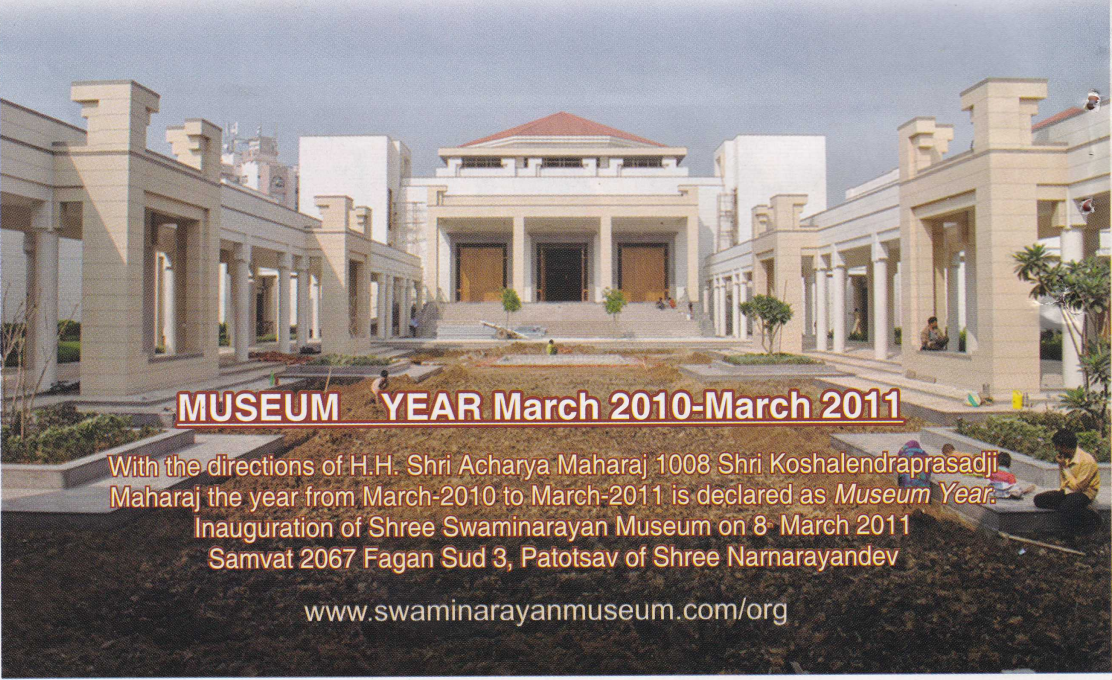
